Enrolments for 2022 Year 9 girls at St Mary's College close at 12noon on Friday 9 July.

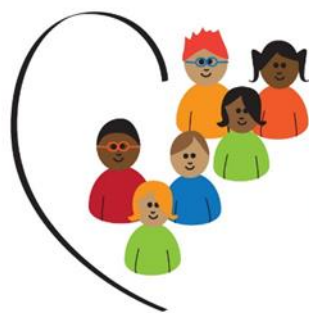
