Kiwi Examinations - Spelling Bee - Year 5-8

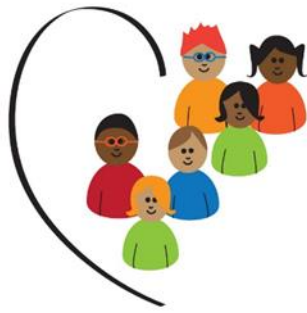
